

**Request for Proposal for Professional Services for
a Fort Bragg Joint Land Study Implementation Project**

Mid-Carolina Council of Governments (COG), in partnership with the Regional Land Use Advisory Commission (RLUAC), is soliciting proposals for a consultant to assist with the implementation of the recently completed Fort Bragg Joint Land Use Study. The scope of work includes creation of a “case management and tracking system”; conducting an “organizational strategic plan for RLUAC”; preparation of a GIS database for jurisdictions that have not fully developed digital zoning layers and other similar digital data layers; development of a “comprehensive Plan / Land Use Plan Supplement for the six counties and fifteen municipalities that participated in the JLUS; and preparation of an “ordinance toolbox” that contains sample wording for military overlays, compatible use overlay districts, light pollution standards and ordinances for the regulation and placement of small wireless antenna.

The JLUS RFP can be downloaded from either the RLUAC (www.rluac.com) or Mid-Carolina COG (www.mccog.org) websites.

To be eligible for consideration, proposals must be received **no later than 5:00 PM on April 30th**. Submittals shall be made electronically to glendadye@mccog.org. File size is limited to 10 MB and consultants are encouraged to confirm receipt of submittals. Multiple files are permitted.
