



## Intent to Bid Questions and Responses

1. Does the letter of intent create any legal obligations?  
**Response: The Contract and Statement of Work is legally binding based on an agreed transference of goods or services, the Intent to Bid would not be a legally binding document.**
  
2. Will there be an opportunity to write to be funded for just in-school youth services?  
**Response: The Request for Proposal (RFP) will include separate sections for in-school and out-of-school programs, allowing prospective Service Providers to apply for either or both opportunities.**
  
3. What are the approximate annual in-school youth program funds available to providers to handle the services?  
**Response: Estimated funding amounts will be included in the Request for Proposal.**
